



2010 Steam School

The Wisconsin Historical Steam Engine Association Inc. is conducting its 7th annual Steam School on September 24, 25, & 26, 2010 at the Rock River Thresheree show grounds located between Janesville, WI and Edgerton , WI.

The class is open to the first 50 people that register. **Pre registration is required.**

The cost of the class is \$50. The fee includes a textbook, the Steam Traction Engineers Checklist, the Case Steam Engine Manual, donuts, coffee and lunch on Saturday & Sunday.

There will be classroom discussion as well as hands-on with full size and model engines steamed up. Class topics include: Steam Theory, Steam Engine Components, Boiler Construction, Operation and Maintenance, Piping, Valves and Accessories, Firing under various loads, Handling an Engine, Boiler Water Treatment, and Emergency Procedures.

There will be an optional catered meal on Saturday night for \$10.00. Guests are invited.
