The **Wisconsin Historical Steam Engine Association** is conducting a steam school on September 24, 25, & 26, 2010 at the Rock River Threshere show grounds located between Janesville and Edgerton WI on Hwy 51.

There will be classroom discussion as well as hands-on with full size and model engines steamed up. Topics include: Steam Theory, Steam Engine Components, Pre firing checks, Boiler Construction, Operation and Maintenance, Piping, Valves and Accessories, Firing under various loads, Handling an Engine, Boiler Water Treatment, and Emergency Procedures.

The class fee is \$50, which includes a textbook, the Steam Traction Engineers Checklist, the Case Steam Engine Manual and lunch on Saturday and Sunday.

The class is open to the first 50 people that register. **Pre-registration is required.** Campsites will be available at the show grounds.

ASOPE (American Society of Power Engineers) test will be offered, but not mandatory, after the school on Sunday for a fee of \$55.
