Fee: The class fee is \$85, which includes a textbook, the Steam Traction Engineer's Checklist, the Case Steam Engine Manual, and for non-club members includes a 1-year membership with the Wisconsin Historical Steam Engine Association. Also credits 16 hours of instruction toward the MN state hobby engineer's license and the OH historical operator's license. Youth scholarships are also available. Breakfast and lunch will be included on Saturday/Sunday also dinner on Saturday evening. Guests are welcome to attend the Saturday evening meal at a cost of \$10.

Details: The class is open to the first 40 people that register. Pre-registration is required. There will be classroom discussion as well as hands-on with full size and model engines steamed up. Class topics include: Steam Theory, Steam Engine Components, Boiler Construction, Operation and Maintenance, Piping, Valves and Accessories, Firing under various loads, Handling an Engine, Boiler Water Treatment, and Emergency

Procedures: This class is not intended to qualify you as an operator, but to give you the basic knowledge of steam engine operation and maintenance.

Primitive camping is available on the show grounds, free of charge. Steam School takes place rain or shine. Parts of the class are outside, please dress appropriately (warm clothes, work clothes/gloves, boots, etc.).
